Salary Adjustment Attorney to the Commission/Chief Legal Counsel (CEA IV) Government Code Section 17529

Executive Summary

The Chief Legal Counsel position is established at a CEA IV level. State policy sets the new maximum rate reserved for CEA incumbents whose duties require membership in the State Bar of California at \$13,381/month and authorizes the Commission to adjust CEA salaries up to 10 percent in a fiscal year.

Therefore, the Commission may adjust the Chief Legal Counsel's salary up to 10 percent, and still remain within the salary maximum.

Recommendation

If the Commission decides to adjust the Chief Legal Counsel's salary, the following motion and action should be taken:
