## **Recent Decisions**

• Department of Finance and California Integrated Waste Management Board v. Commission on State Mandates, et al., Sacramento County Superior Court Case No. 07CS00355, [Integrated Waste Management]

On May 29, 2008, the court signed its Ruling on Submitted Matter granting the state's petition for writ of mandate. The ruling directs the Commission to amend the offset paragraph of the parameters and guidelines to identify offsetting savings from reduced or avoided disposal costs and to identify 100% of offsetting revenues derived from the sale of recyclable materials. The Commission's Statement of Decision is not disturbed with this decision. The judgment and writ have not yet been issued. This decision affects community college districts.
