On July 3, 2007, the Sacramento County Superior Court issued its Ruling on Submitted Matter affirming the Commission's Decision that POBOR constitutes a reimbursable state-mandated program for school districts and special districts identified in Government Code section 3301 that employ peace officers and are, thus, required to comply with the POBOR requirements.
