## **New Filings**

• Appeal to Third District Court of Appeal: Department of Finance v. Commission on State Mandates

Sacramento County Superior Court, Case No. 07CS00079, Third District Court of Appeal, Case No. (unknown)

[Reconsideration of Peace Officer Procedural Bill of Rights (POBOR)]

On September 7, 2007, the Department of Finance filed a Notice of Appeal on the Sacramento County Superior Court judgment affirming the Commission's decision that POBOR constitutes a reimbursable state-mandated program for school districts and special districts identified in Government Code section 3301 that employ peace officers.

### **Recent Decisions**

 County of San Bernardino v. Commission on State Mandates, et al. Los Angeles County Superior Court, Case No. BS106052 [SEMS]

The Los Angeles County Superior Court heard the matter on September 12, 2007, and adopted a ruling affirming the Commission's decision and denying the petition for writ of mandate. The court found that SEMS is not a state-mandated program based on the Supreme Court's decision in *Department of Finance v. Commission on State Mandates (Kern High School Dist.)* (2004) 30 Cal.4<sup>th</sup> 727.
