We are writing to request that we be added to the mailing list for this test claim as attorneys for the State Building and Construction Trades Council of California, AFL-CIO ("SBCTC").

The test claim concerns the State's prevailing wage law, which requires that at least the applicable prevailing wage rate be paid to construction workers on public projects. SBCTC is a federation of labor unions that collectively represent about 250,000 construction workers in California. These working men and women are often employed on public projects and are covered by the prevailing wage law when they perform such work. Accordingly, SBCTC has a substantial interest in this proceeding and should be regarded as an interested person.
