STAFF REPORT ADOPTION OF PROPOSED 2004 RULEMAKING CALENDAR

Executive Summary

Background

Government Code section 11017.6 requires covered state agencies to prepare an annual rulemaking calendar for publication in the California Regulatory Notice Register. While the Commission is exempt from the Office of Administrative Law's (OAL) review and approval, it has traditionally submitted the calendar to keep the public informed of its rulemaking plans. The calendar is due to OAL on January 30.

Proposed 2004 Rulemaking Calendar

The attached proposed 2004 Rulemaking Calendar consists of three rulemakings:

- The first rulemaking would amend current regulations, if necessary, to implement the recommendations made by the State Auditor in the Bureau of State Audits Report on the *Peace Officers Procedural Bill of Rights* and *Animal Adoption* programs.
- The second rulemaking would amend current regulations to streamline the test claim and incorrect reduction claim processes, including electronic service of documents. These amendments will be based on a comprehensive review of the existing statutes and regulations that govern the Commission's business.
- The third rulemaking would amend current regulations to specify procedures for the appeal of Executive Director decisions.

Before noticing proposed regulatory actions, staff would convene workshops to review staff's proposals with affected state agencies and interested parties. This has been an effective strategy to minimize modifications to the original proposal.
