### **Recent Decisions**

1. Petition for Writ of Mandate Denied by Trial Court - County of Los Angeles v. Commission on State Mandates, Malia M. Cohen as State Controller

Los Angeles County Superior Court, Case No. 23STCP00036; (*Municipal Stormwater and Urban Runoff Discharges Consolidated IRCs*, 19-0304-I-04, 20-0304-I-06, 20-0304-I-08, 20-0304-I-09, 20-0304-I-10, 20-0304-I-11, and 20-0304-I-13)

This case addresses consolidated IRCs, which alleged that the Controller incorrectly reduced reimbursement claims for the *Municipal Stormwater and Urban Runoff Discharges* program. The claimants challenged the reductions on the ground that local return revenues received by the claimants from the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority under the Proposition A and Proposition C local return programs and used to fund the costs of the mandated program, are the claimants' proceeds of taxes and are not required to be identified as offsetting revenues. The Commission found that the Controller correctly reduced the costs claimed and denied the IRCs. On August 28, 2023, the trial court signed and entered judgment, affirming the Commission's Decision and denied the petition for writ of mandate.
