#### **Recent Decisions**

#### • Trial Court Affirms Commission Decision

County of San Diego v. Commission on State Mandates, San Diego County Superior Court, Case No. 37-2020-00009631-CU-WM-CTL (Youth Offender Parole Hearings, 17-TC-29)

The San Diego Superior Court, on August 6, 2021, adopted its tentative ruling affirming the Commission's decision denying the test claim. The trial court found that the test claim statutes do not impose any state-mandated activities on local government. The trial court further found that the test claim statutes changed the penalty for a crime within the meaning of Government Code section 17556(g) and, therefore, there are no costs mandated by the state. Judgment was entered on September 1, 2021.
