If you plan to testify and would like to submit any written document for Commission member review, please note that Commission staff will include written comments submitted at least 15 days in advance of the hearing in the Commissioners' hearing binders. Additionally, staff will transmit written comments submitted between 15 and five days prior to a meeting to the Commission members, if possible. However, comments submitted less than five days prior to a meeting or at the meeting, will not be included in the Commissioners' hearing binders and the commenter shall provide 12 paper copies of the comments at the meeting.
