# City of San Diego v. Commission on State Mandates, State Water Resources Control Board, Department of Finance

The claimant is appealing the trial court's ruling, which agreed with the Commission's decision finding that the requirement to test for lead in the drinking water of every K-12 school that a public water system (PWS) serves and that requests testing at no charge to the school does not constitute a new program or higher level of service since the requirement is not uniquely imposed on government, and the provision of water service does not constitute a peculiarly governmental service to the public.
