ADOPTION OF PROPOSED 2007 RULEMAKING CALENDAR

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Background

Government Code section 11017.6 requires covered state agencies to prepare an annual rulemaking calendar for publication in the California Regulatory Notice Register. While the Commission is exempt from the Office of Administrative Law's (OAL) review and approval, it has traditionally submitted the calendar to keep the public informed of its rulemaking plans. The calendar is due to OAL on January 30.

Proposed 2007 Rulemaking Calendar

The attached proposed 2007 Rulemaking Calendar consists of one rulemaking:

Rulemaking 1: Parameters and Guidelines: Reasonable Reimbursable Methodologies and Statewide Cost Estimates

This rulemaking would amend Article 3, section 1183.1 through 1183.3 to revise criteria for reasonable reimbursement methodologies, and the statewide cost estimate process.
