The Department of Finance (Finance) has reviewed the Commission on State Mandates (Commission) draft staff analysis of the proposed statewide cost estimate (SCE) for the Permanent Absent Voters II (03-TC-11) test claim submitted by the County of Sacramento.

Finance has no concerns with the Commission's recommendation to adopt the SCE of \$2,265,372 for fiscal years 2002-03 through 2010-11. We also agree that the total costs for this period may be higher or lower based on the actual number of eligible claimants, amended or late claims, and/or audit findings.


