# STIPULATION TO EXTEND TIME TO SUBMIT COMMENTS ON DRAFT PROPOSED DECISION AND TO POSTPONE HEARING

Dear Ms. Halsey:

In a letter to the Commission on State Mandates (Commission), dated July 16, 2024, the State Water Resources Control Board and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (together, Water Boards) requested a 62-day extension of time to file written comments on the Commission's Draft Proposed Decision and a postponement of the hearing to November 22, 2024.

In a letter to the Water Boards, dated July 18, 2024, the Commission partially approved the Water Boards' request extending the deadline to submit comments to August 29, 2024, and postponing the hearing to November 22, 2024. The Commission stated that the authorities cited in the letter "generally restrict extensions to not more than 60 days and postponements to the next regular hearing date. However, Government Code section 17554 permits, with the agreement of all parties to the claim, the Commission to waive the application of any procedural requirement imposed by this chapter or

pursuant to Section 17553." The Commission further stated that "a 62-day extension from the original due date (to September 30, 2024) will be granted and the matter will be set for hearing on Friday, January 24, 2025, if the Water Boards submit a written stipulation of the parties to the Commission on or before the current comment deadline of 5:00 p.m. on July 30, 2024. The parties to this matter are the claimants, Finance, the Controller, and the Water Boards [(collectively, Parties)]."

The Parties have stipulated to a 90-day extension of the deadline for all Parties to submit comments on the Draft Proposed Decision by October 28, 2024, and to postpone the hearing to January 24, 2025. (See attachment.) The Water Boards respectfully ask that you approve the stipulation.

# STIPULATION TO EXTEND TIME TO SUBMIT COMMENTS ON DRAFT PROPOSED DECISION AND TO POSTPONE HEARING

- 1. By letter dated July 9, 2024, the Commission on State Mandates (Commission) issued a Draft Proposed Decision, Schedule for Comments, and Notice of Hearing for Test Claims 10-TC-02, 10-TC-03, and 10-TC-05. The Commission set the deadline to submit comments on the Draft Proposed Decision on July 30, 2024, and scheduled the hearing for September 27, 2024.
- 2. In a letter to the Commission on State Mandates (Commission), dated July 16, 2024, the State Water Resources Control Board and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (together, Water Boards) requested a 62-day extension of time to file written comments on the Commission's Draft Proposed Decision and a postponement of the hearing to November 22, 2024.
- 3. In a letter to the Water Boards, dated July 18, 2024, the Commission partially approved the Water Boards' request extending the deadline to submit comments to August 29, 2024, and postponing the hearing to November 22, 2024. The Commission stated that the authorities cited in the letter "generally restrict extensions to not more than 60 days and postponements to the next regular hearing date. However, Government Code section 17554 permits, with the agreement of all parties to the claim, the Commission to waive the application of any procedural requirement imposed by this chapter or pursuant to Section 17553." The Commission further stated that a 62-day extension from the original due date (to September 30, 2024) will be granted and the matter will be set for hearing on Friday, January 24, 2025, if the Water Boards submit a written stipulation of the parties to the Commission on or before the current comment deadline of 5:00 p.m. on July 30, 2024. The parties to this matter are the claimants, Finance, the Controller, and the Water Boards [(collectively, Parties)]."
- 4. The Water Boards asked the claimants, the Department of Finance, and the State Controller's Office to stipulate to extend the deadline to submit comments for 90 days

and for the hearing on this matter to be continued to January 24, 2025, based on the circumstances that affect the Water Boards' ability to work on this matter set forth in the Water Boards' July 16, 2024, letter. While the claimants continue to be concerned this matter has not been resolved within statutorily required deadlines, they are nonetheless willing to stipulate as requested out of professional courtesy and as a showing of good faith and cooperation to the Water Boards. The claimants asked that the comment deadline be extended for all Parties out of fairness and in light of summer work demands on claimants, and the Water Boards are amenable to that request.
