STIPULATION FOR 75 DAY EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT COMMENTS OF THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, SAN DIEGO REGION

Dear Ms. Halsey:

By letter dated December 19, 2011, the Commission on State Mandates (Commission) issued a revised notice of complete test claim filing and schedule for comments in the above-referenced matter, with all comments originally due on or before January 18, 2012. The Commission has granted the State Water Resources Control Board's (State Water Board) and San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board's (San Diego Water Board) subsequent requests for extension of time to submit comments on behalf of both Water Boards. Most recently, the Commission granted the Water Boards' extension request, stipulated to by Claimants, with comments now due on or before January 19, 2013.

I am the attorney who will submit comments on behalf of the State Water Board and San Diego Water Boards. The above matter is not yet set for hearing and due to the backlog and pending litigation relating to similar test claims, as identified in your most recent approval letters, the Water Boards propose an additional extension of time be granted for submitting written comments in this matter. It does not appear that any party would be prejudiced by an extension under these circumstances. I have communicated with counsel for the Claimants in the above matter and he has authorized me to represent to the Commission that his clients will stipulate to

a **75** day extension of time, with a due date on or before **April 4, 2013**. As noted in your October 18, 2012, Notice of Extension Request Approval, Section 1183.01(c)(1)(A) of the Commission's regulations provides that extensions by stipulation shall be approved by the executive director for good cause. Accordingly, the Water Boards request that such an extension of time be granted by the Commission. Thank you for your consideration of the Water Boards' request.
