Dear Ms. Patton:

We have reviewed the draft analysis and proposed amendment to parameters and guidelines submitted by Commission staff. Below are our comments and recommendations. Proposed additions are underlined and deletion is indicated with strikethrough as follows:

Page 15:

VIII. STATE CONTROLLER'S <u>REVISED</u> CLAIMING INSTRUCTIONS

Pursuant to Government Code section 17558(c), the Controller shall issue claiming instructions for each mandate that requires state reimbursement not later than 60 90 days after receiving the adopted parameters and guidelines from the Commission, to assist local agencies and school districts in claiming costs to be reimbursed.

COMMENT: The word "Revised" should be included in the title for consistency. Chapter 144, Statutes of 2011 amended Government Code section 17558, which extended the Controller's time limit to issue claiming instructions from 60 days to 90 days after receiving adopted or amended parameters and guidelines.
