Dear Claimant:

The State Controller's Office (SCO) reviewed the above program and discovered that we inadvertently disallowed the filing of claims for fiscal years 2004-05 through 2009-10. Additionally, legislation passed during this time period made some reimbursable activities for this program optional rather than mandatory. Therefore, the SCO has requested the Commission on State Mandates (CSM) to consider amendments to the Parameters and Guidelines (P's & G's) for Interdistrict Attendance Permits to include changes to Education Code sections 46601, 46601.5 and 48204(f) renumbered to 48204(b).

While the CSM reviews our request for the amendments, we will allow filing of claims, for fiscal years 2004-05 through 2009-10 based on the original P's & G's. The filing deadline is January 7, 2012. Claim forms for 2010-11 may be found on the SCO website under "Annual Manuals - School Districts" and are due February 15, 2012. Please note that each year must be filed on a separate claim form.
